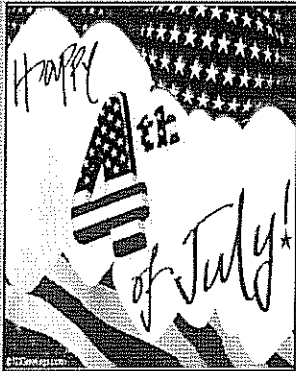

Service Network

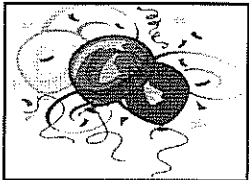
Hello everyone! It's July, and the heat is on! Are you ready to celebrate Independence Day?

Pet Policy Reminder

A new pet policy was introduced in November of 2011.

Please remember that pets are not allowed in common areas such as the lobby, office, community room, elevators, hallways, etc. except when passing through for purposes of entering or exiting the building.

Pets must be carried by hand or in a carrier while outside of the apartment and they must be on a leash at all times. Both buildings have an elevator with a back door that leads directly out to the exit door. This elevator should be used, and pets must be taken directly outside. Do not walk through the lobby area, stop at the front desks, or check your mail with your pet.

If you have requested a reasonable accommodation and lead your pet on a short leash, remember the leash can not be more than 3 feet and should be kept close to your body at all times. The zip line leash should be locked so pets do not run around causing a trip hazard for others.

All staff members have been informed of the pet policy and have been asked to assist in enforcing the rules when necessary. The rules are in place to help create a safe and friendly environment for all. Thank you for your cooperation in following the pet policy of Kinneret.

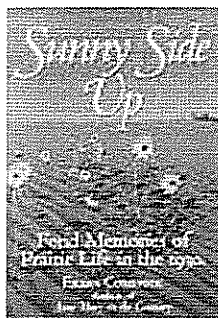

Dear Residents,

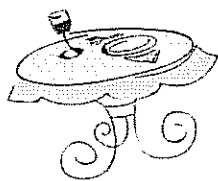

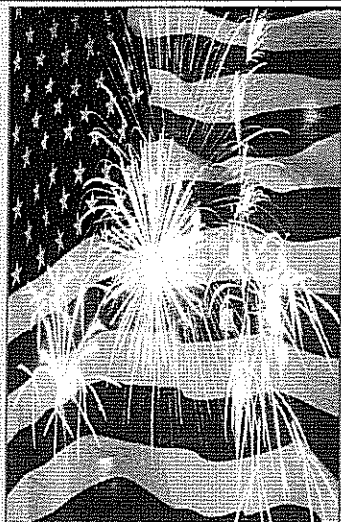
